The Showcase will feature the launch of a new online exhibit: "Charles Macnamara: Arnprior's Citizen Scientis t"

spearheaded by volunteer Laurie Dougherty. A pioneering naturalist and photographer, the exhibit highlights Macnamara's legacy and connection to the land, offering a window into both scientific exploration and local his tory.

Another highlight will be a presentation from AMBA's archivist Janis Hernandez who will have returned from the

International Archives Congress in Barcelona, Spain—an honour extended to only a few archival professionals from

Canada. The trip was 100% funded following a fundraising effort that saw local service organizations, business es and

individuals donate.

For those interested in genealogy, a collection of family histories will be accessible. Volunteers are planning a d emo of

Ancestry.ca and will be available to provide advice whether you're just getting started on your family tree or dee p into

your ancestral research.
