Whereas the federal government has passed a motion to adopt 988, a National three-digit Suicide and Crisis Hotline; and

Whereas the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic has increased the demand for suicide prevention services by 200%; and

Whereas existing suicide prevention hotlines require the user to remember a 10-digit number and go through directories or be placed on hold; and

Whereas in 2022 the United States will have in place a national 988 crisis hotline; and

Whereas the Town recognizes that it is a significant and important initiative to ensure critical barriers are removed to those in a crisis and seeking help.

Therefore Be It Resolved That Council of the Corporation of the Town of Arnprior supports the Township of Bonnechere Valley, and endorses this 988 crisis line initiative; and

Further That a copy of this resolution be sent to John Yakabuski, MPP, Cheryl Gallant, MP, Federal Minister of Health, Canadian Radio-television and Telecommunications (CRTC) Commission, the County of Renfrew and the Township of Bonnechere Valley.

2. Request for Municipal Grant – In Kind Support – Arnprior Lions Club – Waiving of fees for Nick Smith Centre Community Hall



- d) The applicant acknowledges and agrees that the Town of Arnprior shall not be liable for any incidental, indirect, special or consequential damages, injury or any loss of use, revenue or profit of the organization arising out of or in any way related to the approved program/event/ service.
- e) Where applicable, the Town of Amprior must be acknowledged on promotional materials related to the funded activities/event, including but not limited to brochures, print ads, programs, posters, signage and media releases, as well as websites, e-newsletters, and social media campaigns, where possible. The Marketing and Economic Development Officer will require information from the applicant, in advance on what materials/ electronic formats the Town's logo will be included on to ensure compliance with the Town's brand guidelines.
- f) The Town of Amprior reserves the right to an onsite presence, or formal role, at Festivals and Events. Failure to acknowledge the Town's support may result in the inability of an organization to obtain grant support in future years.
