Further That the Rotary Club of Arnprior is hosting a Butter Tart Festival in Robert Simpson Park on August 27, 2022 from 9:00 am to 4:00 pm; and

Further That the Rotary Club of Arnprior has applied for a Special Event Licence to host this event on Town property, as per the Municipal Grants Policy and Town Licencing By-law.

Therefore Be It Resolved That Council approve of providing in-kind support, through the waiving of fees for the Special Event Licence (\$25.00), the Rental of the Robert Simpson Park Gazebo (\$543.00), as well as providing Town staff support for the set up and tear down of the event.

Further That the Rotary Club of Arnprior be advised that it is mandatory to carry sufficient liability insurance and have the Town of Arnprior added as an additional insured for the event; and

Further That the Rotary Club of Arnprior be notified that it is mandatory to follow all public health guidelines that are in place at the time of the event.

4. We Stand With Survivors Campaign – Sexual Assault

Whereas one of the components of the completed model will be a yearly campaign entitled "We Stand with Survivors', with this year being the 4th annual event; and

Whereas the Centre has a goal of hanging four (4) banners stating "We Stand with Survivors" in four (4) different communities throughout Renfrew County, during the month of May 2022.

Therefore Be It Resolved That Council of the Town of Arnprior agrees to hang the "We Stand with Survivors" banner for the month of May, 2022 in the municipality; and

Further That Council direct the CAO to work with Operations and Recreation staff to find the most suitable location to hang this banner; and

Further That this resolution be forwarded to the Status Project Coordinator of the Women's Sexual Assault Center Renfrew County.

5. Municipal Grant Request – In Kind Support – Arnprior Optimist Club – Spring Fling Event (Waive Community Hall and Ice Rental Fees)

That the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Amprior receive the application for In-Kind Municipal Grant Support from the Amprior Optimist Club.







Hello Mayor Stack,

I'm writing to you again this year on behalf of the Women's Sexual Assault Centre Renfrew County.

We are planning the 4th. annual "We Stand with Survivors Campaign". Last years event in Arnprior was very successful, even though we were in the midst of a pandemic.

This campaign is the result of research completed in Renfrew County as Part of a Status of Women Canada Project. We have created a "Rural Model" For female survivors of sexual violence. Throughout the first 2 years of the 3 Year project, we met with many survivors and were also informed in our work By a Survivor Advisory Committee. We listened to survivors and they told us the Model needed to be built around "awareness". The "We Stand with Survivors Campaign" is a direct result of our hearing what survivors asked for.

As you may recall, our plan is to make this campaign a yearly event. We hope to run it in the same communities each year, as well as, adding one new community each year until we have a total of 4 communities on board with us for this campaign. As of last year, we had **your community**, the city of Pembroke, and the community of Eganville. We have reached out and hope to add a 4th community this year, with the intent of representing a significant geographic demographic of Renfrew County.

We are therefore requesting that the Town of Arnprior will agree to let us hang the Banner in town for the month of May again this year, in support of both this specific campaign and May being Sexual Assault Awareness Month. We will also be inviting local Arnprior businesses to hang our poster in their Door/window for 1 day only on May 11th, which is We Stand with Survivors day this year, if the pandemic allows that to happen.

Thank you Mayor Stack for considering our request and for being such great supporters of the Women's Sexual Assault Centre Renfrew County.
