**Further That** the St. Andrews United Church be advised that it is mandatory to carry sufficient liability insurance and have the Town of Arnprior added as an additional insured for the events.

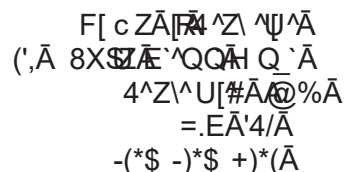

**Whereas** the Rotary Club of Arnprior raises funds which goes toward many community projects in the Greater Arnprior area; including families in need;

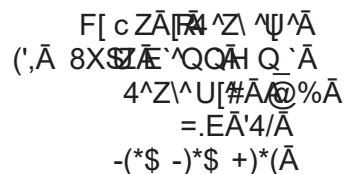

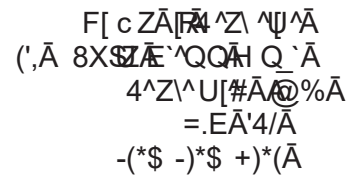


The Ottawa Valley Cycling and Active Transportation Alliance (OVCTA) is organizing and presenting a one day conference on Wednesday September 20th on the economic and social benefits to communities from trails (specifically the Algonquin Trail). The concept is colloquially called Trail Towns. We hope to attract a broad swath of both government and the private sector representatives. We are hoping for 50 plus delegates.

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<p>OVCATA is a voice for cyclists and all active transportation enthusiasts in the Ottawa Valley, advocating for safety and good conditions, bringing people together, and encouraging participation.</p>	
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<p>This event will bring together stakeholders in tourism such as Bed and Breakfast, Airbnb, Hotels, Eateries, and other service providers as well as regulators and government to explore concepts in cycling and active transportation economic development.</p>	
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<p>Arnprior long benefited from visitors by water and rail but of course these have been long replaced by highways and roads. But many people feel that the next big green wave will come from visitors on the trails using active transportation. These people will require food, accommodation, and other services and this has a clear economic benefit to Arnprior.</p>
