2. Municipal Grants Application – ontrac Employment Resource Services (Job Fair)

What is the function of your organization (mandate/key objections)?

The Amprior Optimist Club is a volunteer charitable organization that was formed in 1961 by people who wanted to reach out to help youth and the community; people like you. By providing hope and a positive vision, Optimists bring out the best in youth, our community and ourselves. Over the past 60 years the Amprior Optimist Club has supported many families and organized many community events to aid and encourage the development of our youth and our community. Some of these contributions to the community include the construction of the Sullivan Rink of Dreams, the construction of the McLean Avenue Optimist ball diamond, \$100,000 donation to the Amprior Hospital expansion, construction of the Fourth Avenue playground, contributions to all elementary school playgrounds, contributions to the Amprior Regional Health Foundation (most recently a \$25,000 donation towards the C-Scan fundraiser), the annual Optimist Bobby Legault Canada Day parade, Priorpalooza, Amprior Family Day events, the Amprior Optimist Christmas Parade and the annual Optimist Winter Camival.

Please provide an overview of the service, program or event being supported with this funding.

The Amprior Optimist Club is holding a Winter Carnival event/fundraiser from Friday, January 10th to Saturday, January 18th, 2023. The Winter Carnival is our biggest endeavour each year providing many activities for the community and it is also our biggest fundraiser each year. Over the years we continue to grow this event adding more activities for the community such as previous year's horse and wagon tours of Amprior, dogsledding, a Jr. B Packers game and a Little Rocks event. The Winter Carnival fundraising portion of the weekend will be a men's and women's hockey tournament including 20 teams. There will be games played the evening of Friday the 20th and all day Saturday the 21st. We will be hosting a pub night the evening of Friday the 20th with local entertainment, along with our always popular food auction. Saturday morning of the 21st, we will be serving a shanty breakfast with entertainment by the local Felhaver band and Saturday the will be hosting a wine tasting event. During the week from January 14th to 21st we will be hosting various family and children events. These events will include a movie at the O'Brien Theatre, horse and wagon rides, 3 evenings of family bowling, elementary school skating races, a public skate, a bouncing castle evening, 2 family swim times, arts and crafts at the Amprior Museum, a hockey tournament, 2 children's entertainment acts, a pub night, a shary breakfast, and a wine tasting night. Weather pending there may be events at the Sullivan Rink of Dreams. The entire week and all events are accessible with the purchase of a \$2 Optimist Winter Carnival button. This button was designed by an Amprior elementary school button contest in which students were encouraged to draw a winter carnival picture. A winner was selected from hundreds of entries and rewarded with a \$100 prize along with a shadow box containing their button.

Please explain how this service, program or event benefits the Town of Arnprior and its residents.

This event will benefit many families and children in the Town of Arnprior and surrounding area by allowing them to socialize and enjoy themselves with others in our community. What children and youth do during the critical hours, before and after school, evenings, weekends and holidays, has a profound impact on their physical, social, emotional and academic development. The Optimist Club believes this event will be a great opportunity for the children and youth of our Town to get out of their houses, be kids and have fun. The Town of Arnprior will also benefit economically with hotels, restaurants and stores being visited by the many people from out-of-town who will attend this event. As well, The Town of Arnprior will also benefit econically by operating the bar during the events at the Nick Smith Centre. As a fundraiser this event will allow the Optimist Club to raise much needed funds that our community needs during the current difficult economic situation a lot of families find themselves in. Funds raised during this event will go towards the cost of the above free community activities; as well, as our many annual events and financial commitments the Optimist Club makes each year. The Winter Carnival is very popular and well attended by the community and we would expect this year to be equally embraced by the community. Although the event is organized by the Optimist Club we like to think of it as much the Town's event as it is ours.
