Recommendation:

That the Correspondence Package Number. A-25-APR-04 be received, and that the recommendation(s) outlined be brought forward for Council's consideration.

Action Items:

1. Municipal Grants Application (In-Kind Request) – Arnprior Optimistic Women's Club (Ladies Night Event)

That Council of the Corporation of the Town of Amprior receive the Municipal Grant request from Amprior Optimistic Women's Club; and

Whereas the Arnprior Optimistic Women's Club is an eligible organization under the Municipal Grants Policy and supports residents in our community through support with compassion and efficacy to local schools, "give back" initiatives, and individual families; and

Therefore Be It Resolved That Council approve the request for waiving the Nick Smith Centre Community Hall with bar rental fees, security guard, set up beyond tables and chairs, and stage set up (value of approximately \$972.50 plus HST) for the Annual Ladies Night Event to be held on May 10th, 2025; and

Further That Arnprior Optimistic Women's Club be advised that it is mandatory to carry sufficient liability insurance and have the Town of Arnprior added as an additional insured for the event.

2. Municipal Grants Application (In-Kind Request) – Renfrew County 4-H Association (Cooking with Dairy Club)

That Council of the Corporation of the Town of Amprior receive the Municipal Grant request from Renfrew County 4-H Association; and

Whereas the Renfrew County 4-H Association is an eligible organization under the Municipal Grants Policy and supports residents in our community through developing

and implementing programs that help young people become contributing members of their communities; and

Therefore Be It Resolved That Council approve the request for waiving the Nick Smith Centre Community Hall rental fees (value of approximately \$547.50 plus HST) for the Cooking with Dairy Club to be held on May 24th, 2025; and

Further That Renfrew County 4-H Association be advised that it is mandatory to carry sufficient liability insurance and have the Town of Arnprior added as an additional insured for the event.

To ensure a smooth operation of our event, we are asking for four dedicated individuals to oversee bartending and ticket sales. As past years have proven a great partnership and understanding and the capacity of our event, four staff is the perfect amount to aid us in serving our guests and having the safety of others in mind. Additionally, our club members will be on hand to provide invaluable support, ensuring compliance with the strict no-alcohol policy beyond the venue's doors. We also ask for support with the cost of our mandatory security guard (the NSC has taken the initiative to do the hiring) to supervise the venue doors and ensure the continued safety of our guests |



| | and to enforce the housekeeping policies of the Nick Smith Centre. The Women's Optimistic Club Members will stay until the end of the event for clean up. As there is an event booked for the following day, we have been notified that cleaners will be present to help with floors, garbage and table clean up. The day set up will require tables to be brought into the hall as well as stage components. I have been informed of a cost associated with this and ask for support with this amount. Here is an outline of what I have been provided with in regards to fees from the NSC: \$470 - Hall with Bar \$315 - security guard (\$45 an hour, from 7pm -2am) \$150 - 6hrs of setup beyond tables and chairs \$37.50 - Stage set up (1.5 hrs at \$25 an hour) Total = \$972.50 + tax = \$1098.92 This is an estimate and Kasia will provide us with a final total. |
