Time & Placement

- Garbage must be placed at the curbside after 7:00 pm the evening prior to collection but must be placed at the curbside by 7:30 am on the day of collection.
- During winter months, please do not place garbage bags/containers behind, on top, or in the side of snowbanks.
- Ensure all garbage is bagged and securely tied, even if it is in garbage cans.

Restrictions

- Large items (stoves, refrigerators, furniture, mattresses, hot water tanks, automobile parts, scrap metal) will **not** be collected from the curbside. These items may be disposed of at the Arnprior Waste Disposal Site. Tipping fees apply.
- Garbage will **not** be collected if it contains **recyclables**, large quantities of dog or cat feces, items not properly contained, loose ashes and/or sawdust, **Household Hazardous Waste**, is overweight, oversized, over the limit, or contains **Leaf & Yard Waste**.
- Any loose garbage will not be collected.

Bags, Containers, Sizes, Weights, & Limits:

- **Maximum of Two (2) Bags Every Week**
- The **maximum** weight for each Bag or Container is **50 lbs** (22.7 kg)
- **All Overweight Bags/Containers will not be collected**
